Dear Friends,

Children are mentioned a lot in these past few chapters of Matthew. Jesus, in his teacher role, turns to them when talking about a society that sees them as the least of these. Society back then seemed to have a ranking system when it came to people. Women and children were dependent on the men in their families for their very livelihood. For those who care for them. Jesus was always looking after the marginalized. That's because he saw a great chasm between the haves and the have nots. Sadly, not much has changed.

One of our core values is hospitality. We love to be in fellowship with one another. And that is such a good thing! Jesus experienced hospitality. But, he also saw those how those same communities pushed aside the smallest in their midst often, forgetting about them

When we ever come across text in the Bible that is repeated over and over again it is meant to be a signal to us that something important is being said. The phrase "The last shall be first and the first shall be last" is one that appears often lately in our gospel passages. Jesus turns the tables on the world's ranking system and puts children in a place of honor and value. He's saying to those nearby, and also to us, pay attention to them. They are important!

We love to see our children in worship. Their carefree ways charm us. But there is so much we could do for them. We could tell them how important they are through our actions. Many fears have been expressed over the declining presence of our young ones. Recently, our leaders have been talking about the 2024 budget. We've listened and we've taken a good look around ourselves. While we have growing programs in our church not much of it is centered around this key demographic. That is why you will be hearing more about building into our budget a part-time position focused on children and youth. My prayer is that we trust God's Spirit to move us in ways that grow God's kingdom for all. I ask that your prayers join ours remembering Jesus words "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of heaven belongs to such as these."

On November 5th, we will be turning our Narthex into a space of remembering and lighting candles for those that


