Many people collect small offerings in a special container at home throughout the year as they find themselves feeling grateful. Others just give one special gift per year when the Thankoffering service happens.

The founders of Women of the ELCA decided back in 1988 that Thankofferings are to support the ongoing ministries of the churchwide women's organization. Our founders would be amazed to see what that covers these days! Our ongoing ministries include our many online and printed communications channels, our justice and advocacy work, training and development for elected leaders throughout the women's organization, our constant work in support of congregational and synodical women's organizations, the administration of our grants and scholarship programs, all that goes into our triennial convention (the business meeting, that is), and so much more.

We will be holding our Thankoffering service during worship on Sunday, November 9th. Pastor Crystal from Church of Our Savior in Fond du Lac will lead our worship service. The theme for the day reflects on our gratitude that our God provides wonderful people to accompany us on our journey through life. For years, our congregation has offered meals to the community any time there is a fifth Saturday during a month. We do this through the Loaves and Fishes program organized by the people of Trinity Episcopal Church downtown. We began working with their congregation because we wanted to feed the community, they had an established program, and I had an "in" through working in their office. They had always offered meals on the first and third Saturdays of each month. By covering the fifth Saturdays, we were able to expand their program during those months with extra weekends.

During this entire time, I've been the primary coordinator for these meals. I can see that I won't be able to continue the task forever. For our November meal, I'd like to work with one, two (or more) additional people through the planning and preparation time. It's always a good idea to share the information and work among a group — instead of counting on just one person to do it all. This way, we can gradually expand the number of people who can continue our outreach efforts. The total time invested is 7-10 hours 4 or 5 times over the course of a year.

Here's the tricky part: I'm not good at asking for help. I know that many of you are willing to help if asked, but I don't know who to ask. I'll need you to contact me to say you're willing to look into helping here. You can call me at 920-279-3795, or email me at church: worship.coslc@gmail.com.



REMEMBERING THE SAINTS

Remembrance Displays
Oct. 19th - Nov. 2nd



Day of the Dead (Día de Muertos) is celebrated in Mexico and other Latin American countries in different ways, but with a common purpose — to celebrate those who have passed away. The celebration, which takes place on Nov. 2 and the days leading up to it each year, is one of the most renowned traditions in Mexico and is a way to remember loved ones by displaying their photos and favorite items, and leaving gifts and offerings at a personalized altar.

We will have 2 shelving units set up in the lobby which will provide members space to make a remembrance altar to their loved ones that have passed. This tradition in Mexico serves not only as a remembrance but a celebration that the dead live on in a life promised by Christ.

Let us help you lift up those you have lost. These displays are a happy, colorful celebration where the dead are honored and the deceased are remembered. These displays also help us remember to celebrate the joys of life. Throughout Mexico, altars called las ofrendas ("offerings") are set up in homes to welcome home the souls of the dead.
