Recently, I attended my 3rd Leading Well Retreat in Carefree, Arizona. Funded by a Siebert grant, I was able to attend this annual retreat and conference one more time at no cost. Leading Well is a four-day training retreat for church leaders that offers practical learning, sabbath rest, and collegial support. For me, it was a time for renewal. The speakers we had were amazing and I learned so much. I was reminded to slow down enough to my mind and body.

We listened to author and coach Rozella Haydée White. She focuses on nurturing life-giving and justice-seeking love in this world so that all can thrive. In her recent book, she speaks about the peace we all hope for...

"Peace seems like an elusive concept these days. Everywhere I turn, I hear of conflict and destruction. When there is talk of peace, the concept is sorely misunderstood and mis-used. We romanticize peace, as if it might spontaneously arrive. But peace is far from this simple."

Rozella believes the one thing that keeps us from peace is people's belief that "there isn't enough. Enough time. Enough resources. Enough jobs. Enough money. Enough joy. Enough love. This belief in scarcity is the biggest sign that we don't believe that we belong to each other—leading to the absence of peace and a world of chaos.

As we await the birth of another Christmas, I pray that this intentional time of waiting and watching forces us to still ourselves enough to realize how much Jesus is enough for us. And in that satisfaction, may we enjoy this special time as we focus on the one who came down to us out of love - God Emmanuel.


Welcome to our New Synod Youth Positions




